

ScoutsCymru Youth Commissioner Survey 2020 – Volunteers Guide

Why we're launching a survey

At ScoutsCymru, Youthshaped Scouting is at the heart of what we do. It gives our young people the opportunity to mould their Scouting journey whilst developing vital Skills for Life.

Youthshaped Scouting comes in many forms, from a Beaver lodge voting for which game they want to play at the end of the night to an Explorer planning their Duke of Edinburgh expedition.

We want to create a picture of how young people across Wales are shaping their Scouting so that we can develop resources and projects to support our volunteers. To do this our Youth Commissioners have designed two surveys, one for young people and one for adults. The surveys should take no more than 5 minutes to complete.

What do I need to do as a volunteer?

There's a couple of things we're asking you to do. The first is to complete the survey yourself as a volunteer, your questions are slightly different to those that we're asking the young people!

The second thing is to send the survey link to the parents of the young people in your group along with the parents guide that can be downloaded from the ScoutsCymru website.

Is the survey anonymous?

Yes, the survey is anonymous! The only question we ask is what District you are in so that we can target our projects.

We love badges! Can this go towards any?

Our Youth Commissioner Team love badges as well so we're pleased to let you know that it can go towards the ScoutsCymru Democracy Challenge Awards! As we currently can't do log chews and forums this can be used in their place as our young people shaping their wider Scouting experience. Parents can screenshot a page at the end of the survey to show you that their child has been involved.
