## Emergency Procedures

### Weather



Eryri National Park experiences around 3,000mm of rain annually. Similarly, we are a mountain location, so experience mountain weather systems such as snow coming in quickly and expanded ranges in temperature from day to night, for example.

However, warmer weather has seen that rainfall evaporating more quickly, and not making it into our water supply, meaning very occasionally we have to implement drought conditions (e.g.: prioritised usage, chemical toilets). You will be informed in good time before your stay if we are under drought conditions.

Users are reminded to prepare before their stay.

Cornel may request to see proof of a wet-weather plan for large groups.

The impacts of bad weather are covered by our other Emergency Procedures:

- Access
- Electricity

If during your stay bad weather affects your ability to use Cornel, please advise a member of the Warden team. Phone numbers are on the wall by the House telephone and in the Guest Manuals.
